Where is Cleantech Forum Europe being held?

Daily events will be at Maison de la Poste, Rue Picard 5/7, 1000 Bruxelles, Belgium.

The 18th Annual Cleantech Forum Europe Reception, Dinner & Awards on Wednesday will be at Train World, Pl. Princesse Elisabeth 5, 1030 Schaerbeek, Belgium.

How do I get to the Forum at Maison de la Poste?

There are many ways to travel to Maison de la Poste.

- Metro stop: Ribaucourt or Ijzer stops and then a 10 mins walk to venue.
- Bus: 14, 20, 57, 88 stop Suzan Daniel.
- Free shuttle from Gare du Nord. A free and regular shuttle service marked **Tour & Taxis** is provided every day of the week from 5:30 am to 10 pm. There are shuttles travelling every 5 to 10 mins. from Brussels-North (Simon Bolivarlaan) to the site of Tour & Taxis, back and forth. An extra stop is included between noon and 2 pm at Rogier Plein.
- Parking: Parklane Picardstraat 13, 1000 Brussel. €3/h €22/day.
- You can also call an Uber, but it is recommended to schedule it in advance at peak times.
- By Bike: there is a Villo stand right out front

How do I get to Train World?

Attendees should plan to travel to Train World on their own. Cocktail hour begins at 6:30 pm.

You can easily access Train World using public transportation. Just take the free Tour and Taxis Shuttle from Maison de la Poste to Gare du Nord (North Station) and take a train to Schaerbeek. The whole trip takes less than 20 mins. The CO2 emissions for this journey are 136 g. By car, they would be 818 g.

Where is the registration desk so I can pick up my badge?

The Registration and Held Desk will be located at Maison de la Poste at the entrance of Ticket Window Hall and opens Tuesday at 1:30 pm.
